

Dear Sir.


I am very sorry to inform you, that there is no trace of the still missing members of your crew. The wind has been blowing from the shore and the corpses must have gone far out into the Baltic Sea.

Sgts Hill and Moon are transported to Hälsingborg for burial together with 19 other Englishmen. They were transported to the train in presence of a military honour guard, and the Swedish soldiers at Åhus had sent a fine wreath to the coffins.

I was very sorry not to be able to say goodbye because your bus had already left the station in Falun, when I came out. I'm herewith sending my best regards to you all.
